

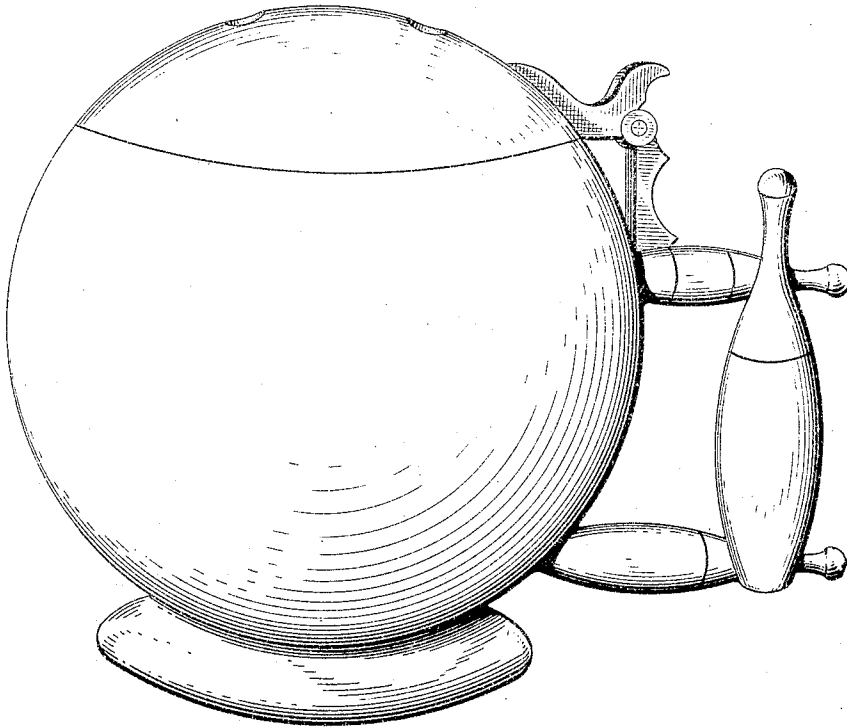

## DESIGN FOR A MUG OR STEIN.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 37,298, dated January 24, 1905.

Application filed December 14, 1904. Serial No. 236,877. Term of patent 7 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HARRY S. MADDOCK, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Trenton, in the county of Mercer and State  
5 of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Mugs or Steins; and I do hereby declare that the same is fully and clearly illustrated in the accompanying drawing, forming part of this specification.

The drawing illustrates a side view of a mug 10 or stein embodying the design.
